

Pastor Angelo Merli



The testimony shared in this newsletter is truly AMAZING; may God be glorified by its humble retelling here. My wife and I have known Pastor Angelo Merli for a number of years; we first met him at the Carletonville Bible College in South Africa. Italian by birth, but raised in South Africa – he worked for several years in the mines, but now owns his own metal shop where he does lathe and millwright type work for

a variety of clients, but mostly for area mining related concerns. Brother Angelo is currently the pastor of a new multi-cultural congregation in Fochville (Northwest Province) named Salvation & Gates of Praise PCG. He is fluent in at least 6 languages (Italian, English, Portuguese, Fanagolo, and a couple other African languages), but best of all he loves Jesus with all of his heart.

Earlier this year he hurt his shoulder, but shrugged it off as nothing serious. Then on a rainy March 9th he was attempting to cover the hole on a leaky house roof with an old scrap of conveyor belt. However, his shoulder couldn't take the strain, he lost his balance and fell backwards off the roof, landing on his back. For nearly 2 hours he lay paralyzed on the ground before he could be taken to the hospital. Upon examination the doctors discovered Angelo had 5 broken places in his pelvic bone, plus two lower lumbar vertebrae were broken.

The attending physician told Angelo he would likely be in a wheel chair for the rest of his life. This news did not discourage him, rather he was more determined than ever that he would walk again. As a matter of fact, during his 13 day stay in the hospital, he managed to hobble to the bathroom. When his doctor "caught" him coming out of the water closet one day he asked, "How long have you been doing this?" Angelo replied, "Ever since you told me I would likely never walk right again."

His doctor sent Angelo home insisting that he use the wheel chair. Unfortunately, both of Angelo's sons worked and his 13 year old daughter was in school. Tending to his own personal hygiene was "difficult", somehow he managed to help himself. Anyway, since he was home alone he attempted to walk. After being in a wheelchair for five days, he bravely got up and took a few painful steps. Eventually, he went outside and starting walking; his legs began to strengthen so

he kept adding steps. Before long he was walking on the Fochville-Potchefstrom highway! Motorists would stop to ask him if he needed a ride, to which Angelo replied, "No, I feel fine just walking." Indeed, it felt so good to walk...he just kept walking. However, after walking nearly 21 miles from his home he felt extremely tired and phoned his oldest son Mornay, "Son, can you please come and get me?"

His son asked, "Where are you Dad?" Angelo responded, "Son, I'm about 35 kilometers from you on the Potch road. Can you come and get me?"

Today Angelo is completely healed; truly a testimony to the wonder-working power of God in his life and ministry.

Almost a month after his father's accidental fall, on April 12th Pastor Angelo Merli's son, Mornay, also met with a life threatening experience. Mornay works at an LPG gas bottle exchange store in town of Fochville. boss asked him to check the leaky regulator on a tank that a customer had just returned to the shop. Using the correct wrench to make an adjustment, he soon heard a hissing sound.


MORNAY'S STORY



Upon rechecking the regulator- that's when the an explosion happened. Everywhere he looked there was fire. However, he had enough presence of mind to grab a fire extinguisher and go outside where he doused out the flames. In no time the inside of the shop was gutted out by the fire.

At the hospital Mornay was treated for third degree burns on his arms and neck. He suffered for three miserable sleepless nights, yet his doctor sent him home instructing him to return to the hospital at regular intervals for clean bandages. This procedure was carried out for about 8 weeks.

As you can imagine, he asked himself why did this happen to him. At the end of this time period when his bandages were removed, the physician said, "Son, you don't have 3rd degree burns!" Indeed, his arms showed only minute scars. This fact was verified by Aaron Emerson who examined Mornay's arms during our visit in South Africa.

I pray you have entered this New Year with determination, expectation, and vision for God to manifest and do in your life, all over the world, what we have never seen Him do before! We can look at the condition of the believer, and the church, and see the Words of Jesus clear as day; "the harvest is great, but the workers are few".

Many have given up on their dreams and cashed them in to live up to the expectations of the status quo. Then secondly to set-up our first ever Minister's Conference in Nigeria for the Summer/Fall of 2019. We are sure to add NEW pastors to the PCG, and NEW churches to the PCG through this Holy Ghost endeavor!

Greetings from J. Mark & Susan Holbrook, your Field Representatives to Kenya.

We are happy to report that the PCG is alive and well in the nation of Kenya! The Gospel is being preached with signs, wonders, and miracles following. Souls are being saved. People are being filled with the Holy Spirit. New churches are being established. There is so much to tell that we don't have room to share everything in this letter. Here are just a few of the highlights:



We were able to return to the town of Nyangusu in western Kenya where we spent a full week teaching and training a group of more than 100 pastors.

As the week progressed, we were also holding revival services in the evening. As the word was taught during the day, a demonstration of the power of God was manifested at night.

One of the late afternoon sessions had us teaching about divine healing. As we moved directly into the evening service we called for the sick to come forward for healing. Approximately 65 people came to the front. Our pastors were surprised when I told them that none of the American ministers were going to lay hands on the sick. I wanted them to understand that the same power to heal the sick was in all of us. As we prayed together and they laid hands on the sick, we saw miracle after miracle.

One 20-year-old woman with abdominal



issues had been sick since she was 11. She had been in at least three different hospitals, had seen many doctors, and had had multiple surgeries. After all the doctors' efforts, she was still in constant pain. As the power of God fell in that place, she began to weep and rejoice because all her pain was gone in an instant. Three days later, she would still break into tears as she testified that there was no pain and she was able to eat without feeling sick.

In another afternoon session, we were teaching about the infilling of the Holy Spirit and His work in the life of the believer. That evening as a strong thunderstorm began to roll through, we called for those who wanted to receive this same Holy Spirit. The storm was growing stronger as a group of 23 individuals made their way to the front. The sound of the rain on the tin roof was almost deafening as one of our U.S. ministers was preparing to lay hands on them. At that moment we lost all electric power, but a Heavenly power source flooded the building and all 23 that were seeking the Holy Spirit were wondrously filled and began speaking in other tongues.

2019 promises to be the best year we have ever had in Kenya. With the help of District Youth Directors Josh & Lynnea Martinez, preparations are being made to lead a group of young people from the East Texas District on a missions trip early in March. This is sure to be a life-changing experience for all of us. We will be taking the gospel into elementary, jr. high, and high schools during the day. In the evenings we will be holding open-air crusade meetings where we will see hundreds receive salvation. These young people will also be laying hands on the sick and watching divine miracles happen as the Lord works with them, confirming the word with many miraculous signs.



We are in the early planning for two additional trips in 2019. They are likely to be in August and November. The August trip will include two family crusades, one in Nairobi and the other in Nyangusu. We will be focusing on families with school age children. Seminars will be held at each location for pastors and children's ministers to help give them the tools and the passion to better reach children with the message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

While we are very thankful for the support we have received, we would welcome additional partners in ministry. Your faithful and generous giving makes everything we do possible. Digging In

An Article written by Nancy Kingen Missionary to China



When you were a child, did you believe you could dig your way to China? Well I did and fifty plus years and here I am! This marks the twentieth year of serving and living in Asia, with a detour here and there. I am so blessed to be able to serve the Chinese. I have had so many wonderful learning experiences, some filled with laughter and some with gut wrenching tears. I would never trade them for all the tea in China!

These past three years have been a relearning if you will. The laws have changed so much towards freedom of religion. The government has decided they want to "sinicize" all religions and return to more traditional socialist and communist practices. They are arresting and closing churches at an alarming rate. My friend's church has been shut down here, and my study temporarily suspended. It doesn't matter, Church closures and incarcerations do not stop God or His obedient and faithful servants! The Gospel will be proclaimed regardless of the rescinding of all religious rights here or in other countries.

When we look at the natural, we sense fear and worry about the future of Christianity here in China. We need a change of perspective. Believe me, these intense persecutions are solidifying and unifying the churches here.

In Luke 5, we have the story of Jesus and the great haul of fish. There's a word that is paramount to our potentiality in reaping a harvest - (here it's a huge one, 1.3 billion and growing). In verse 5, Peter makes a pivotal comment, "nevertheless at Your Word."

Nevertheless is an adverb meaning it indicates a cause, it can be a producer of an effect, it can be motivation, a determinant or an originator. The cause is "at Your Word." The originator is the "Source- Jesus of course." This is one of the greatest statements of faith in the Bible, in my opinion. The effect is what I want to elaborate on.

After a negative sentence (failure to catch anything), it serves to mark a transition to something new. It's transitional, in that it moves from a negative to a positive. It is the difference between what we can do on our own and what God can do through our obedience and faith. Their capitulation was the bridge from the natural to the supernatural. Even though their own experience and expertise told them it was not going to be productive, these fishermen listened to a Carpenter. Their catch was unprecedented in a location that was hopelessly unproductive the night before.

The second aspect I want to focus on is that "nevertheless" is a point of transformation. There's a conversion that takes place when we obey God in faith. Number one there is a change in condition, they went from fishermen to "fishers of men." Secondly their priorities changed. They recognized their own limitations and submitted their will to the power of "nevertheless!"

So when I take my eyes off of Jesus and I observe the intensifying persecution in China, it can be discouraging. Then in faith, I submit to the power of "nevertheless" at Your Word, acknowledging and expecting God to move in unprecedented ways!

Thank you for your faithfulness in praying and supporting the work here in China. I have been teaching English. It is one of the best evangelistic tools to reach people here. It's just a tool God uses it to open doors that otherwise I would never be able to personally open.

During the Christmas Celebration program, the children heard a story, they watched a movie, they sang Christmas songs, they had special Christmas snacks, and they were then given gifts by "Santa Claus". The children were very happy beyond our expectations. Therefore, we are very happy!







Exchanging gifts for Christmas is not part of the Ethiopian Christmas culture. Very few westernized and well to do families buy Christmas gifts for their children. For the older children, fourteen years and older, we gave a promise of a trip to a place with hot springs sometime later in the spring semester. We will have swimming in the hot pool with fun games. We will do gatherings around the campfire and much more. This will be a "once in a lifetime experience" for these children. 

Below are pictures of the 2018 graduating class. After they graduate, they are sent out on the field to Pastor new or existing churches, they are given a salary and their rent is paid. While in Ghana on September 2018, I met and spoke to the students at the Bible school. Please keep them in your prayers.









Needs:

- 1. Afram Plains District (PCG farm project site) .The land for this project is already purchased, but money is needed to prepare the field for cultivation and to purchase seeds.
- **2.**Toilets... PCG Ghana wants to build toilets in some of the poor villages in Africa. The cost of erecting 1 toilet is \$2000 US.
- 3. PCG-Ghana would like to buy a plot of land for the new Church they started two months ago at Dawa with 21 members. Currently, they are worshipping in the classroom behind us. After East Mosul was liberated from ISIS we drove to Mosul to deliver food and Bibles AND to see what was left of Jonah's Tomb. From atop Jonah's hill we watched the war in West Mosul and prayed for the defeat of ISIS.

ISIS had dynamited the mosque built over Jonah's tomb. I found a stairway in the rubble that led down into the small mountain. We entered and found the ancient foundations of King Asarhadan's temple. We found ancient pottery, human bones, large stone carvings, and the place Jonah had been buried 2700 years ago. ISIS had been digging for things to sell on the Black Market.

We visited one of the many church's destroyed. ISIS had turned the large cross into a billboard for their evil black flag.





Our Church and team are doing good and growing. The US Consulate invited us to start another church inside their compound here in N. Iraq. The Vice Consul asked us specifically to bring the children because they never see children. There are 150 Americans working there under the highest security imaginable. The State Department doesn't have Chaplains like the military.

Our 7th load of Bibles was smuggled safely to our brothers in the persecuted church in Iran. The last load was our largest yet. We have more to send. We've sent over 40,000 Bibles and 42,000 Story of Jesus booklets total. Each Bible costs about \$3 to send. The underground church thanks you for your help.

A person under extreme persecution there had to be smuggled out recently. Our team got him out and a European country quickly gave him a visa to start a new life there. I asked him how he came to faith. He said he came to church seeking truth for 2 years. One day in church he felt a tap on his shoulder. He turned around and it was Jesus wanting to talk to him. A few nights later he was born again. Many believers from there have similar testimonies.

I wanted to give you an update on my last trip to Ethiopia. There was an opportunity to go to Western Ethiopia near Sudan for the first time in several years due to some positive political changes and violence beginning to be replaced by a new hope. We were able to visit three water projects that have been completed in Muslim dominated areas. The women and children in one area are coming from four villages to make use of the water from the project we completed! We were encouraged by the house church and the believers who were standing strong in their

My name is Drussilla Rofkahr, missionary appointed to Ethiopia. Abdii Boruu, House of Hope, is an Ethiopian Resident Charity Organization created to help the poorest women and children in our town of Eiere, and the nearby rural area. We are located forty-four

kilometers west of the capital city of Addis Ababa. "Abdii Boruu, House of Hope" is translated to mean " A place where you can find hope."

Here is a brief update on what is happening this year. We just received land to build our own compound for our project! We will be building: a house to host interns who will be a part of the project, 4 to 6 large classrooms for women's training, 3 offices, a Kindergarten with 4 classrooms and a small orphanage which will consist of a room with 4 beds, which the Women and Children's Social Affair has asked of us. The vision of Abdii Boruu House of Hope is unlimited!

We just concluded our first graduation of 11 women. We were able to give them seed money so they can start their own businesses! Thank you for the opportunity you've given them to start their own businesses. Their lives have been changed! We are still sponsoring 14 children for education and some medical expenses. We are able to have 3 ongoing staff, a Project Manager, accountant and a guard.

Please join us in prayer for: \$10,000 to build a fence and large gate as required by the government, \$50,000 to <u>begin</u> the building of the facility/compound itself, for all of the women and children that we are able to reach and for God to send an intern who is qualified and passionate to our project.






Iliana update:

As many know we returned home from our internship in Guatemala after **one** year of serving and we since then have been able to start itineration. Itineration (to those that may not know) basically means that we are traveling to churches around the U.S. raising our budget for our mission to the Amazon Jungle. We feel that we are moving well on raising that budget, though monthly support is currently a major need. We are embracing the walk of faith of itineration as God continues to show us that He is our provider.



Upcoming Trip

We have been feeling a pressing from Holy Spirit to reconnect with the Yagua Tribe in February (during our itineration season) to reassure them that we indeed are returning to them (seeing as that was the last thing we had told them). The issue of trust with outsiders goes back generations with these tribes. Most Amazonian tribes believe that outsiders only want to take from them or want to get close just to kill them! Yes, this is a major obstacle that we will face but we believe that with Jesus shining through us they will see us as different and be able to trust our love towards them. Tribal ministry takes time, but God showed out for the Yagua Tribe with healing miracles the last time we saw them. Their hearts are ready, and we cannot wait any longer to give them Jesus as sickness and death is common within the jungle.
