

I love doing crusades with signs and wonders, and reaching out to the unreached people! However, when I was visiting Zambia last year, I saw a great need for spiritual education. I felt the Lord speaking to me from Hosea 6:4, "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge." The conclusion from this is simple; before we reach out to *unbelievers*, we need to educate the *believers* with the word of God.

After prayer and seeking the Lord for a solution, I was led to our good friend and partner, Bishop Charles, who already operates a Bible school in Malawi. I asked him if he could to travel from Malawi to Zambia to teach. He felt the Lord urging him! Therefore, we began a Bible School and implemented four teaching modules of ten days each. Bishop Charles, together with one other teacher, travel two days to Zambia, simply to present this primary Bible teaching.

Amos, one of the students, says this school has already transformed his life. He was about to leave the PCG and maybe even turn away from the Lord, but attending school has set his

heart on fire. He also suffers from depression and almost took his own life, but now he believes in revival and has a renewed vision to transform his nation.



Another student, Pastor Loyd, shared that he has received so much Biblical knowledge during the first ten days of Bible school, that he began to wonder how he could have ever done pastoral ministry over the past years without it. He felt convicted and asked God for forgiveness due to his previous Spiritual ignorance as a Christian leader.

In this photo, the students gathered after a final exam was given on January 10<sup>th</sup>. They are overjoyed and want to express their deepest appreciation to the PCG regarding this new initiative. They all say that the teaching will restore the PCG in Zambia!

Please join us in prayer as we reach Zambia for Christ. We will continue Bible teaching in March and again in June. It is our desire to fully equip local PCG pastors, and then send them out to reach local people. At the end of the fourth module in June, we will host a huge outreach festival. The aim is to bring revival to the church with the Word and the Spirit, and to reach out to the city Ndola, Zambia with signs, wonders and miracles. Our budget has been set for this event and we are seeking the Lord to fulfil each need. **Bible school in Ndola, Zambia.**

To make a long story short, we planned for four modules of ten days each of teaching during fall-19 and spring-20. Bishop Charles and one other teacher travel to Ndola and give the teaching. Right now as I am writing this newsletter, we are in to the second module.

Here the students gather after a test that was done in January 10<sup>th</sup>. They are so happy and express their deep appreciation towards the PCG that we have taken this initiative to materialize the vision of giving them the WORD and the SPIRIT. They all say that the teaching will restore the PCG of Zambia!

**Now we will continue with two more modules like this! The dates for the two coming modules are March 15<sup>th</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> and beginning of June. At the end of the fourth module we want to do a big outreach festival. The aim is to bring revival to the church with the word and the spirit and to reach out to the city Ndola with signs, wonders and miracles.**

**FOLLOWING ARE MY JOURNAL ENTRIES FROM MARCH 1994 DURING A TRIP TO BELARUS WITH REVEREND FRANK MARTIN FROM ROGUE RIVER, OREGON, A MOSCOW PASTOR AND THREE YOUNG MEN FROM HIS CHURCH, OUR INTERPRETER, JANE, MY LATE HUSBAND, MARVIN TURNER, AND I, SARAH—NOW BRYANT:**

**3-10-94, THUR:** Met at *Moscow Russian PCG* office to leave for Belarus. 8 went: Pastor Sasha, Andrew, Vladimir, Pavel, Jane, Frank Martin, Marvin, and I. Jane forgot passport, so her parents met her at Kievsky station. Train started moving while only Marvin, Frank and I were on board, but it stopped, and Jane and guys boarded. Andrew cut middle finger, left hand, on lid of large can containing cooked rice. I had one Betadine pad. It was extremely hot on top bunk (overnight train).

**3-11-94, FRI:** More of same for breakfast--chicken, rice, etc. Viktor Lapatin met us at Gomel, *Belarus, where we changed trains*. A lady doing craftwork on shuttle train gave Marvin beige, dresser scarf with gray trim. Frank won two people to Christ. Andrew and I practiced *our English/Russian*. Pastors Yevgeny and Nikolai met us at Bobruisk train station. Walked in mud *from melting snow* to bus stop. Waited, then they hailed a car for Viktor, Frank, Marvin and I. Jane, Frank, Marvin and I stayed in the home of Viktor, Natasha, Maxim, Ira, Larissa.

**3-12-94, SAT:** Went early to car mart before leaving at 11:00 by train for Yelizovo service. Changed trains at Asipovichy. Walked through pines into town for 3:00 p.m. service. Pavel spoke, Andrew, *(miraculously, with cut finger)* played keyboard, and he and Pavel sang. Frank preached. Many came forward for salvation.

**3-13-94, SUN:** Bobruisk for noon service. Frank greeted congregation, Andrew played my guitar, and he and Pavel sang; Marvin preached. Large altar service. Wedding immediately after service. Went to wedding reception at bride's home. (She is the sister of Sasha from *Brother Clendennen's* school.) Course after course was set before us. We ate for at least 3 hours. Andrew played guitar, and we sang praise choruses intermittently--*between varied speakers!*



**3-14-94, MON:** Jane resuscitated (*by answered prayer—after asphyxiation*). Went to Pastor Yevgeny's house by train and had lunch. His wife cooked pancakes in open hearth oven. Stopped by Nikolai's house where they have some of *their* church

services. Saw paratroopers as we waited for train to go to Asipovichy. Walked in rain (past building where tonight's church service is to be held) to a home where we prayed—and ate, of course. They had the best blueberry crescent pastries I have ever eaten. We prayed for a Pavel and Sasha who want to be preachers (their mother told me). A blonde *girl* came from behind me and asked if she could interpret for me, and I told her to help Marvin who was sitting in front of me. I was filming and taking pictures with Brother Martin's camera, and ours. Pastor Sasha began service with first sermon, then Brother Martin preached best sermon yet—even though he told later he didn't even want to preach that night. Only one man came forward for salvation, but Nikolai told us on the train going home that God put the church split back together tonight.

**3-15-94, TUES:** Nikolai came early with smile on his face. We thought Leonid was coming at 4:00, but he came after service tonight. This was Bobruisk night. Brother Martin's camera fell on the floor when the seat folded up as I picked up the video camera and our 35mm camera to capture Viktor's offering baggage. The flash attachment was ajar, but still took pictures. Marvin fixed it, praise God! Vladimir had crowd with him and used Dima (Yevgeny's son) running sound for example of ignoring Holy Spirit. Brother Marvin (and Jane) preached. Many responded to altar call for healing. I took

picture of group at bus stop after service. Viktor told us on bus on way home that we would have to leave at 9:00 a.m. for Oktyabrsky (because there are no more trains during the day) and come home at 4:00 a.m. in the morning, so Marvin said we, *he and I*, wouldn't go. Leonid filled out ministerial application, and Marvin took polaroid photo.

**3-16-94, WED:** Pastor Sasha, and the 3 evangelists went with Yevgeny to Oktyabrsky to service in a home (because Communist city officials won't allow them to rent a building with Viktor's "Good News Mission" seal). Nikolai came and spent day

and part of night. He decided to join PCG fellowship. Saw funeral bus parking across street and thought we might, yet, get to go to Oktyabrsky. Viktor did overturns while *standing* on a swing in his back yard.

**3-17-94, THUR:** Pastor Sasha, Andrew, Pavel and Vladimir came as soon as they got home from Oktyabrsky. Viktor took our group to market, and we bought bread for trip. Nikolai and Yevgeny were there when we arrived back at Viktor's house. We ate on planks at large table. Talked about effectiveness of crusade (video) and laid hands on Nikolai as presbyter and Viktor and Yevgeny as pastors, and prayed for unity.

*Rented* van took us to train station. Left Bobruisk at 6:00. Made change and left at 9:00. Nice train, but rocky ride. 3-18-94, FRI: Andrew, Vlad, Pavel viewed video of trip. Arrived at Belorussky train station in Moscow at 12:30. Very tired.

ADDENDUM: Back in Moscow on Sunday, Frank preached and, also, a charismatic missionary from Georgia. A lady came to the microphone saying her son had shot himself, and she was on her way to the bridge this morning to jump off, and she wanted to thank us for saving her life--she was saved upon hearing the sermon theme confirmed by other, American preacher.

Now, twenty-six (26) years after the journaled ministry trip to Belarus, Pastors Nikolai and Yevgeny have immigrated to the USA and live with their daughters. Sadly, Leonid is deceased, as are the wives of Nikolai and Yevgeny. Thank God, for their faith and works! Viktor remains in pastoral ministry in Bobruisk, Belarus, and has retained connection and fellowship with the Pentecostal Church of God.

In June 2009 Doug had the privilege to visit our PCG churches in Lubumbashi, Democratic Republic of Congo. While at the GECA Mines congregation, the young pastor showed him two old photographs of which he immediately took snapshots. The first photo showed the pastor and his family taken with former Missions Director Dr. Donald Gee during his visit to Central Africa (circa 1988).

The second photo was made in 1990; it showed the same pastor with both of us. He asked, "Do you see that lad in the middle in both photos?" With humility he announced, "That's me... my father was the pastor of this church. Of course, now he is in heaven...and I have become the pastor!"

Definitely, Africa's leaders of tomorrow will arise from among the sons and daughters of our current pastors and church members. Why are children a heritage from the Lord (Psalms 127:3)? Because, each generation will pass on their spiritual knowledge of the Lord to the next generation. What did Jesus say? "Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you." ## DELAYED ITINERATION



Trinidad sits less than 7 miles from the South American coast of Venezuela, but the journey is full of risk. *"It is better to die with the family trying (to come to Trinidad) than to stay in Venezuela and die slowly"*, they shared. Jobs are their greatest need in Trinidad and language is their greatest barrier to finding work. Partnering with the local church to

# A Personal Miracle

to ICU, I sat waiting for word on his condition. About this time I got a phone call from Pam Shute. She is the daughter of the former World Missions director and is also a nurse. Pam told me that while she was getting my dad's birthday card ready, she had a strong burden for my dad. She walked the floors and prayed at her piano bench for my dad. This started about 7:45 am which was before he went into cardiac arrest. She did not feel release from prayer until 8:30. Pam just had to call to find out what was going on. This was such an encouragement to me. God gave someone a burden to pray for my dad even before he went into cardiac arrest. Twenty four hours later, he was breathing on his own. I believed that God along with Pam's prayers is what saved his life.



Modern day troubles in Persia/Iran:

Since the Islamic Revolution in Iran in 1979 the country has been led by radical Shia Islamic Religious leaders. In Shia Islam they believe the 12 Imam (The Mahdi a religious leader) who disappeared down a well hundreds of years ago will return. He will return as their messiah with Jesus to conquer the world and kill all Jews and Christians. He will only return when the world is in chaos and the Shia believe they can hasten the Mahdi's coming by helping to start world wide chaos. Not the kind of government to be trusted with nuclear technology. It brings us closer to the wars of Ezekiel 38 and 39.



Good news in Iran:

A large move of God has swept across Iran the past years. We estimate 500,000 to 2 Million new believers in Jesus are in Iran. Outside of Iran there are huge communities of Iranians around the world where many more are now following Jesus. Many in Iran and surrounding countries are having dreams and visions of Jesus and it is leading to their salvations. Muslims believe a dream is the only way God can speak to people. They take dreams seriously and the Lord is using them. Pray for more dream visitations.

Till Today we have smuggled 68,500 Bibles to the persecuted churches across Iran. We've had 13 successful shipments with #14 and #15 currently on the way. Thank you for your help and prayers in this project. Imagine the blessing of helping all these new believers get their first Bible! I think God likes that too.



Panorama: On a recent road trip to see an old Iraqi Christian friend we stopped for tea on a half built bridge over the Zab River. This is the location where Alexander the Great of Greece fought and defeated King Darius of Persia. When King Darius saw he was losing he fled. His own soldiers killed him for running away. Alexander continued fighting and taking Greek culture across modern day Iraq, Iran, Afghanistan, Pakistan, and India. Alexander died in Babylon in 323 BC.



### New US Consulate:

The US is building a giant new Consulate/Embassy near us. There are 1000 constructions workers from Pakistan and 100 are Christian. They meet every night to sing and pray. I teach the Bible once a week and pray for the sick with a translator into Urdu.



When the US killed Iran's biggest terrorist everyone in N. Iraq was jubilant. Everyone feared that guy and he had a lot of blood of Americans on his hands. For 40 years that man lived by the sword and he finally died by the sword. In retaliation Iranian rockets started flying over our house to hit American targets. Amazingly, about 5 of the 29 rockets actually hit their targets. Many friends left the country but we chose to stay. First I feel like it's the job of a pastor to stay with his proverbial sheep even in dangerous times. Second, as a former Marine I know it is a criminal offense to leave your post without orders from your Commanding Officer. In my case - God. The answer to 1000 questions is just be led by the Holy Spirit and the Word of God. In 10 years in Iraq we've seen multiple evaluations of Americans. It is scary and you must choose to have courage.



It still costs an average of \$3 to send a New Testament and \$6 to send the whole Bible.

We have an Iranian Pastor in America who is excited about "shipping Bibles" to Iran. He was a Muslim and a religious scholar before giving his life to Christ 20 years ago. His organization will raise and pay 50% of the shipping costs! If you can help they will double all we raise for shipping.


### Hosea Project

# News From Haiti

For the majority of 2019 the news from Haiti has not been good news. The country has been wrecked with political violence and strife. Daily riots have been the normal. Schools have been closed since May. Inflation and unemployment have skyrocketed. Haitian currency, the Goude, has lost almost all value. The cost of food and fuel have doubled or more.

Recently, European news outlets have begun reporting on the humanitarian crisis that is developing. It is being reported 3.7 to 4.1 million Haitians are now in a severe food crisis. That means nearly 40% of Haiti presently can't afford proper food. And the numbers continue to rise weekly.

On December 21<sup>st</sup> I communicated with Bishop Raynald. He stated a calm had developed in the last few days. He attributes this to respect for the Christmas season. He reported that the streets in Port Au Prince were peaceful. It is expected to remain for several weeks, giving a much-needed relief to the beautiful people of Haiti.

The faithfulness of God has been present with our people in Haiti. All of our pastors have reported that they and their people are safe from the violence. All of our church properties have been spared any damages. Several were forced to close for a few weeks because of gang violence but all except Cite Mews have reopened.

The next critical date for Haiti is January 13, 2020. National elections were not held in October 2019 and exactly how the President handles what should be the first day of the new parliament session is crucial. Pray for this day.

We had been working on the establishment of an orphanage during 2019. We had also been working on plans for short term mission trips. Those plans were delayed but they are not cancelled! We are preparing to return and complete the work started at the first opportunity.

Though we have anxiously waited to return to the field and begin discipleship with the people God has called us too.

The very first encounter with the Peruvian tribe Jesus healed the blind, our last trip we began the raising up of pastors, and as we were leaving the deaf were healed! For us it just confirms that Jesus has our backs and as long as we show up, he will continue to remain faithful. It is rumored our tribe now has a rule that you must accept Jesus and be baptized to live within their tribe, "I mean, talk about culture shift!" It is the partnership of each of us that is making their encounter with Jesus possible and you are a bigger part in that than you may realize!
